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MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER

Dear Families

I hope this newsletter finds you all well, healthy and happy.

This term has certainly been an eventful one! The children have settled beautifully and are all working diligently on their projects. We are delighted that they can now go out on field trips and have experts in to support them all with their learning. We were also pleased to welcome M&M Productions last week who performed the children's classic Treasure Island to Y1-Y6 crews. We are also pleased to now be working with Liverpool Football Club coaches who are joining us on Wednesdays to support both reading for pleasure and sports (apologies to our Evertonian families!).

Covid19 Update: Well, we had hoped it would be plain sailing this term but alas, it is not. We currently have more cases in school than in the previous 18 months, despite retaining most control measures. I have met with Public Health England (PHE) as we reached the threshold for 'outbreak' (like most schools in Knowsley currently) and I can share that they were very pleased with the manner in which we are doing all we can to control transmission. I believe in speaking my truths with you as our families, and it does feel very challenging currently - I would therefore like to thank you all whole heartedly for your ongoing understanding and support with our control measures that affect you most as families, especially our one way system which is a health and safety measure approved by PHE. I will keep you updated as this term unrolls but I am pleased that we had a stable, and not increasing number of Covid19 cases in children.

I hope you enjoy the next couple of weeks and we look forward to engaging with you all for our remote Parents evenings later this month.
