Hal and the End Street - It's 1974 and you're about to meet Hal. Hal is thirteen and finds being a teenager hard work. He's autistic and people don't always understand him. Written with autistic teenager Will who has also done the illustrations this chapter book gives a voice to an autistic main character. **Ideal for Y3 up.**



Hal and the Parties - It's 1977 and Hal is back! With parties, celebrations, the Jubilee and a new college, Hal has a lot going on. Having Autism makes these experiences even more difficult. Luckily, Hal has his family, friends and Jenny the dog to help him out. **Ideal for Y3 up.**
