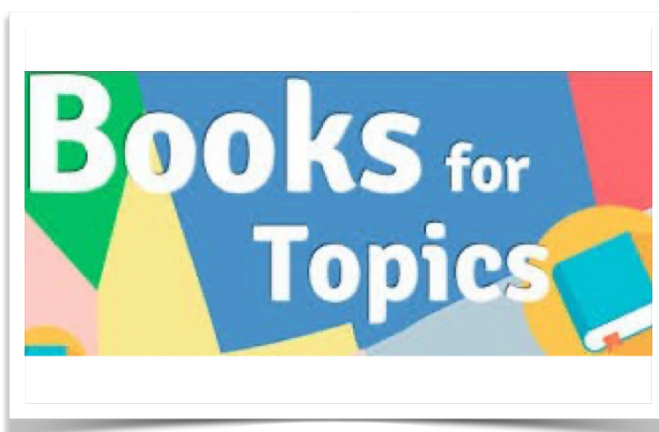
When children have a home library, as little as **20 books** of their own, they achieve **3 more years** of schooling than children who don't have any books at home.

Read **20 minutes** a day and you'll read **1,800,000 words** per year.

Children learn **4,000 to 12,000 words** per year through reading.

Reading in Class

Each class from Nursery onwards has regular whole class reading lessons where one text is read and studied for up to 6 weeks at a time. Often these texts are linked to our projects that the children are learning about in class and are also sometimes linked to their writing lessons. These books can be found on our school website.
