Community Building Games:

Pass the Squeeze:

Everybody holds hands.

Everybody closes eyes. The first person starts with a small squeeze. As each person feels the squeeze reach them through one hand, they send it on to the next person with their other hand. Now try sending the squeeze the other way.

Discussion:

Feedback on safeguarding concerns –

Reading shed: Only adults should close the door on the reading shed – it should be left open at all times by children, when it is in use.

Cameras: There are **no** cameras in the children’s toilets – the things that can be seen are actually sprinklers which are there in case of a fire, and to help keep us safe.

MUGA: School are looking at ways to close the corner off so that it is more secure. **Reminder:** Children should **not** be talking to adults on the other side of the fence – even if you know them. **If you ever feel unsafe, tell a teacher/adult straight away.**
