It is expected that schools will see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
2. The profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
5. Increased participation in competitive sport

### **Stockbridge Village Primary's Vision for the Primary PE and Sports Premium**

Stockbridge Village Primary is committed to improving the PE and Sports provision in the school. To help achieve this the school has created an action plan for the 2022/23

The school has received £17,680. £16,000 plus £5 for each pupil in Y1-6, the DfE uses figures from the January 2022 School Census to achieve the final figure.
