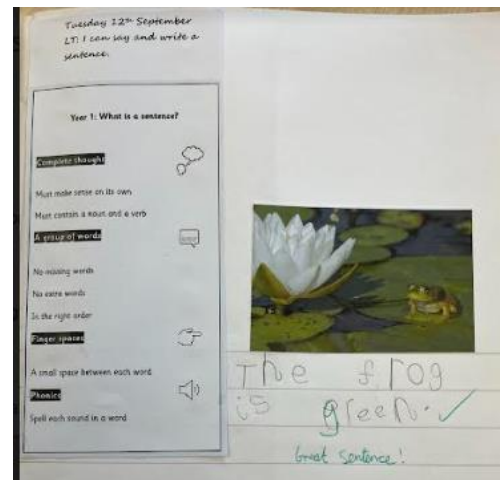

Well done Freya!

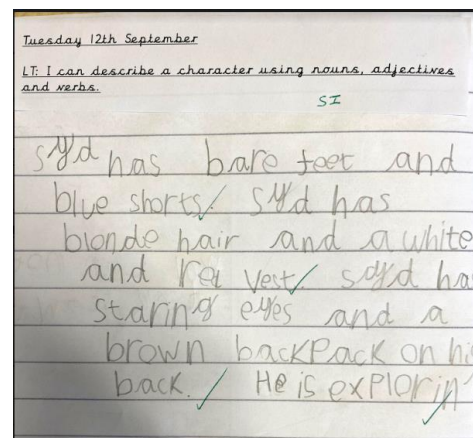


Year 2: Adrian

Adrian used nouns, adjectives and verbs to create his descriptive sentences.

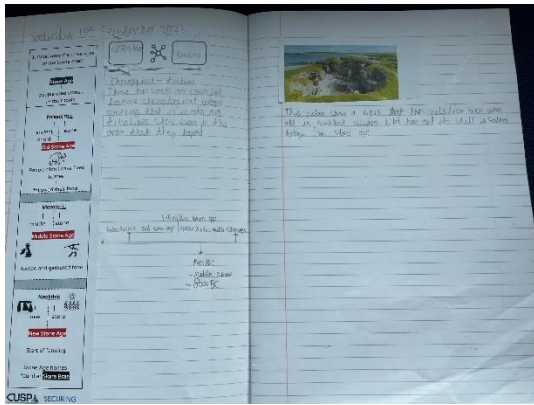
Well done Adrian!

Well done Rayyan!



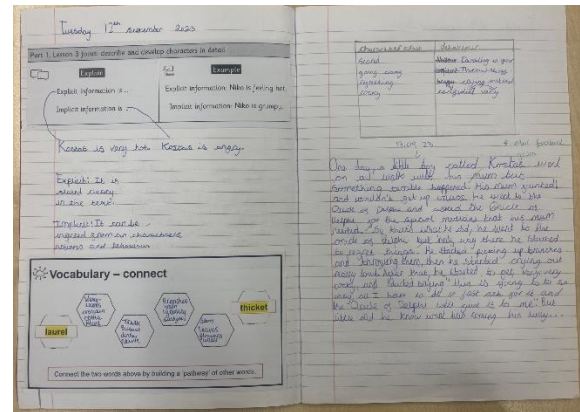
Year 4: Molly

For his wonderful character descriptions in writing! Harvey included everything I asked and more. He worked really hard on his punctuation but most importantly his presentation is fab!

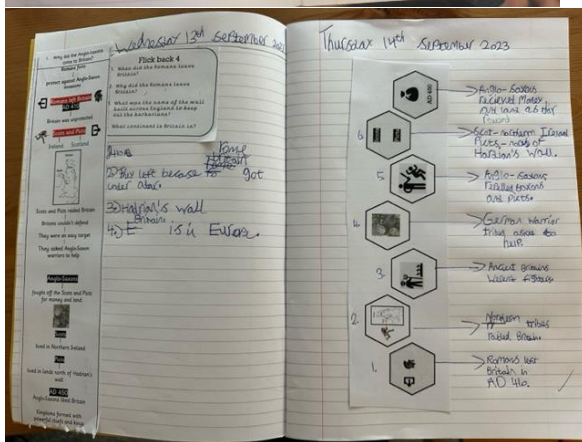
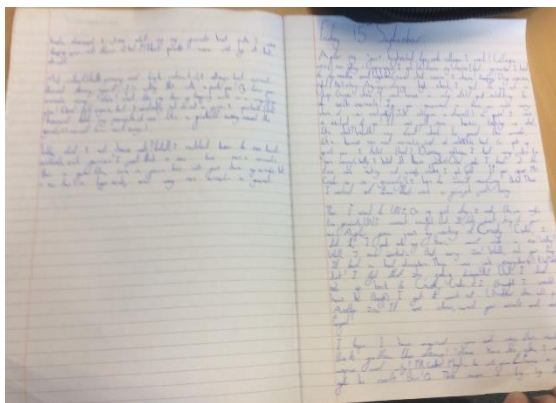
